FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

2019 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

The bill changes the method for calculating earned compliance credit for probation and parole. This will require significant programming changes to the Alaska Corrections Offender Management System (ACOMS). The department does not have the in-house capacity to make these programming changes and complete testing in a timely fashion to meet the effective date of this legislation. Therefore, the department will need to contract with a firm for the programming. Absent a confirmed knowledge of the final scope of work and bids from vendors, the amount included is an estimate based on similar work completed for the department on ACOMS in the past. The projected programming costs for the earned compliance credit changes is \$100.0.

This bill requires the Parole Board to post all decisions of the board, orders for parole, and parole conditions imposed on a publicly available Internet website with the exception of material that is statutorily required to be confidential. This will also require programming to develop a website that is useful to the public, very secure, and, if possible, updated from ACOMS automatically. The department projects that will cost \$75.0.
