Budget Action

The House Finance Subcommittee on the Department of Environmental Conservation Budget held four meetings on February 6, 13, 20, and 27, 2014. Review included missions, accomplishments, challenges, budget trends since Fiscal Year 2006, the Fiscal Year 2015 budget request, the future of the Oil and Hazardous Substance Release Fund, air quality regulations, an update on House Bill 80 (Chapter 1 SLA 13) cruise ship discharge rules, the clean-up of tsunami debris, and the recent closure of the Flint Hill refinery in North Pole.

The subcommittee accepted the Governor's amended proposal with the following adjustment:

• Removing \$1,434,700 Unrestricted General Funds in the Division of Water, Water Quality Allocation, for costs associated with state primacy for dredge-and-fill activities (Senate Bill 27, Chapter 12 SLA 13).
