RECOMMENDATIONS:

The House Finance Budget Subcommittee for the Office of the Governor submits the following recommended operating budget for FY2017 to the House Finance Committee:

The Unrestricted General Fund difference from FY16 Management Plan to the House Subcommittee budget recommendation is a reduction of \$293.9, which is 1.3% below FY16 Management Plan.

While not under the purview of the Subcommittee, the Subcommittee recommends that the on-year election funding that the Governor requested as a \$3.8 million capital project, be added as a language appropriation in the House Finance Committee.

BUDGET ACTION:

The House Finance Budget Subcommittee for the Office of the Governor reviewed the FY2017 budget request, including amendments, and recommends the following actions:

Accept the Office of the Governor's budget proposal, which includes these highlights:

- Commissions/Special Offices Human Rights Commission, Reduced personal services, travel and contractual services for savings of \$37.2 UGF
- Executive Operations Executive Office, Reduced personal services, travel, and contractual services for savings of \$156.3 UGF, increased Inter-Agency Receipts by \$99.9, and deleted two vacant positions
- Executive Operations Governor's House, Reduced travel and contractual services for savings of \$12.4 UGF
- Executive Operations Contingency Fund, Reduced expenditure level by \$50.0 to \$550.0 UGF
- Office of the Governor State Facilities Rent Governor's Office State Facilities Rent, Reduced expenditure level by \$30.0 UGF
- Office of Management and Budget Reduced personal services, travel and contractual services for savings of \$43.0 UGF
- Elections Reduced personal services and contractual services by \$60.0 UGF; deleted an administrative clerk position; added one full-time and one part-time position to implement the Toyukak settlement with \$95.0 UGF and \$251.5 Election Fund; and added Statutory Designated Program Receipts of \$29.0 in anticipation of a grant from the Pew Charitable Trust to participate in a data sharing agreement with an existing group of states.
