The amount allocated for Geological & Geophysical Surveys includes the unexpended and unobligated balance on June 30, 2020, of the receipts collected under 41.08.045.

AI: Fire Suppression Preparedness

Intent

It is the intent of the legislature that the Department of Natural Resources propose to the legislature for the 2022 fiscal year a funding mechanism for "Fire Risk Reduction" that captures a set percentage of all funds resulting from federal reimbursements for fire suppression and a set percentage of all funds resulting from cost recovery efforts for fire suppression from insurance settlements and private parties. The percentages captured shall be determined by the department.

The proposed funding mechanism should create a renewable and predictable revolving "Fire Risk Reduction" fund, a set percentage of which will be allocated annually to provide for continued creation and maintenance of risk reduction projects. Should the department find that a change in statute is necessary in order to create this fund, the legislature requests that the department propose such legislation for the 2021 legislative session.
